

MAPS Seeking Consultant Project Manager

Project Goal: To facilitate a MAPS workgroup to develop/synthesize a set of best practices for embedding a culture of safety based on previous work of MAPS and its members along with emerging national standards.

Product: A road map to guide health care providers on how to embed a culture of safety within in their organizations. The goal is for these best practices to become a community standard through a statewide call-to-action across all settings of care.

Project manager description/duties.

- Project manager will:
 - Take lead to work with MAPS staff and MAPS Operations Committee co-chairs to prioritize, implement, collaborate, and communicate with MAPS culture workgroup members, culture experts, and other stakeholders as appropriate.
 - Provide support for all aspects of the MAPS culture workgroup and designated subgroups, including gathering and disseminating information to/from workgroup members, researching best practices, developing toolkits, facilitating meetings and conference calls.
- Project manager should have experience with:
 - Facilitating meetings
 - Researching, collating, and synthesizing best practices
 - Development and implementation of comprehensive patient safety/quality projects and learning and implementation collaborative
 - Ability to work with multi-stakeholder group and lead consensus process across diverse perspectives
- Health care experience and knowledge of patient safety and patient safety culture preferred

Project will be for a total of 210 hours over a 6 month period (~8 hours per week) not to exceed \$21,000 (\$100/hour).
