
Stratis Health is a nonprofit organization with a mission to collaborate and innovate to improve health. We work nationwide and across the continuum of care, including for:

Rural Health

- Worked with more than 45 rural communities in 6 states to support development of community-based palliative care services.
- Nearly 150,000 rural Medicare consumers have benefited from efforts to improve care coordination and reduce hospital readmissions.
- More than 1,350 critical access hospitals are supported through 45 State Rural Flex Programs to increase quality data reporting and drive care value.

Patient Safety

- Analyzed and created action plans for more than 4,400 "never events" at Minnesota hospitals and surgical centers over more than 15 years.
- Provided technical assistance to 24 Medicare-certified Indian Health Service-managed hospitals to assist with pandemic response and emergency preparedness and to help reduce opioid-related mortality, improve patient safety, and improve transitions of care among the American Indian/Alaska Native community.

- Improved the health of public program members and reduced disparities by facilitating collaborative health plan performance improvement projects in Minnesota, including on:
 - Comprehensive diabetes care (current)
